

Demand of Loan from World Bank for Orissa Cyclone

2316. SHRI SANATAN BISI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government of Orissa has requested for loan from the World Bank to the tune of Rs. 7.5 thousand crores of Rupees to meet the recent calamities;
- (b) whether Government of India is processing the same; and
- (c) if so, the details therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI S.B.P.B.K. SATYANARAYANA RAO):

(a) Government of Orissa has prepared a preliminary brief outline of a reconstruction programme for the cyclone affected areas envisaging a requirement of Rs. 6,700 crore, to be implemented with assistance from the World Bank.

(b) and (c) On the request of the Government of India a World Bank mission has visited the State between 29th November and 4th December, 1999. The Bank will send another mission some time in January, 2000 for finning up of sector-wise assistance.

Farmers' Welfare Fund In Himachal Pradesh
