- (b) Yes, Sir. The programme costing about 15 crores will address to the issues of all the major states of the country.

  - \*To prepare resource inventories for each agro-eco system.
  - \*To identify constraints and improve land use efficiency and resource sustainability.
  - \*To delineate micro level variation in each of the identified watersheds.
  - \*To review the present cropping pattern/system in relation to economic viability of production system of a given agro-eco system.
  - \*To develop eco-region specific land use options based on land evaluation (resource) and socio-economic factors and issues.

\*To monitor the state of health of natural resources (land and water).

Impact analysis of the suggested land use options for improvement and/or modification.

(c) and (d) In order to increase the production and the productivity of these crops, the following Centrally Sponsored Schemes are in implementation in Orissa:

- (i) Accelerated Maize Development Programme;
- (ii) Intensive Cotton Development Programme;
- (hi) Sustainable Development of Sugarcane based cropping systems;
- (iv) National Pulses Development Project;
- (v) Oilseeds Production Programme.

These schemes are on the pattern of 75:25 sharing basis between Central and State Govts. Financial assistance is provided for various critical inputs, demonstration, trainings etc.
