Report of NMC on communal riots

723. MISS MABEL REBELLO: Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the National Minorities Commission has submitted its recommendation on the Gujarat incidents during August, 1998;

(b) if so, what are recommendations submitted by the Commission;

(c) whether Government have given due consideration to those recommendations to control the communal riots in the country; and

(d) if so, what are the steps being taken by Government to deal with such incidents?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT" SHRIMATI MANEKA GANDHI: (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The National Commission for Minorities has made 10 statutory recommendations to the Government of Gujarat under Section (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992.

(c) and (d) The Government has brought these recommendations to the notice of the State Government of Gujarat for necessary action. As per provisions of the National Commission for Minorities Act 1992, the State Government of Gujarat is required to place the action taken report before the State Legislature.
