All the above schemes are being continued in the, Ix Plan also. Funds required for implementation of these scheme will be met from the Rubber Plantation Development Scheme and Infrastrueture Development in Non-traditional] Area for which the proposed outlays for the IXth plan is Rs. 5561 lakh and Rs. 1440 lakh respectively.
