(a) whether there was a decision of Hon'ble High Court that all the children Whose names were recommended by MPs and approved by the Admission Approving Committee of K.V.S., before

the date of filing writ petition will be admitted in Central Schools;

(b) if so, whether even then such children could not get admission and these cases were referred to Ministry of HRD; and

(c) the decision of Government in this regard and what action Government propose to take for giving admission to such children during ensuing academic Session?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) to (c) The judgement of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi declaring the Scheme of Special Dispensation Admissions in Kendriya Vidyalayas as violative of Article 14 of the Constitution, exempted the admissions finalised till 28.8.98, the first date of hearing of the case, from its purview. All children in respect of whom admission orders were issued by KVS before 28.8.98 were allowed to take admission in accordance with the orders of the Court.

**Maintenance and Preservation of
Monuments/Sites by A.S.I, in Tamil

2890. SHRI V. P. DURAISAMY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of various monuments/ sites being looked after by the Archaeological Survey of India in Tamil Nadu;

(b) the details of amount sanctioned and spent on such monuments/sites in the state during the last three years; and

(c) the details of future plans under consideration of Government for preservation and maintenance of monuments/sites in Tamil Nadu?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Under the AM&ASR Act of 1958 the ASI has declared 410 monumenbts as protected. These monuments comprise of Mosques, Forts, Monoliths, statues, Mandaapas Palaces, Churches, Buildings, Inscriptions, excavated sites, mounds etc.
