Need for Non-Formal System of Education

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether a study of district of Primary Education Programme has revealed a significant decline in the enrolment of students in the formal schooling at primary levels and the need for stress on non-formal system of education, as a means to eradicate illiteracy;

(b) if so, what progress was made in spreading and propagating non formal system of education during the Eighth Five Year Plan; and

(c) the targets being proposed under the Ninth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURALI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) and (b) As per available information on District Primary Education Programme (DPEP), data relating to enrolment from 42 districts indicates that between 1995 and 1998 net enrolment in primary schools has increased. For children belonging to remote and unserved locations, working children, street children and school dropouts, alternative schooling facilities are being provided under DPEP.

During the Eighth Plan, the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Non-Formal Education (NFE) was extended to cover about 70 lakh children in 2.79 lakh centres.

(c) The strategy for Ninth Plan envisages improvement and consolidation of NFE programme.
