(a) how far the Rajiv Gandhi's dream of having at least one Navodaya Vidyalaya in each district in the country has been fulfilled, indicating the number of districts still without such a Vidyalaya and the number of those with such Vidyalaya; and

(b) the names of districts in Maharashtra/MP/UP/Gujarat where such Vidyalayas are not yet set up?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI); (a) The Scheme of Navodaya Vidyalayas envisages establishment of one Vidyalaya on an average in each district of the country. 444 Districts existing at the commencement of the VIIIth Plan have been fixed as the target for opening Navodaya Vidyalayas. So far 404 Navodaya Vidyalayas have been sanctioned. Number of Districts covered and remaining in each State is at statement-I. (See below)

(b) The State of Madhya Pradesh has been covered to the extent of 100% with regard to the districts as existed at the commencement of VIIIth plan. The names of districts in Maharashtra, UP and Gujarat where JNVs are yet to be established are given in Statement-II.

- (b) if so, the details of funds allocated under the National Literacy Mission and Operation Black Board and released to States during the last five years, yearwise;

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Yes, Sir. The amounts mentioned in the newsitem referred to in the question are unspent balances with the State Governments/implementing agencies.

- (b) State-wise allocation of funds is not made under National Literacy Mission and the funds are released on project basis. State-wise break-up of funds released under the National Literacy Mission and Operation Black Board during the last 5 years is given at Annexure. [See Appendix 186, Annexure No. 10]
- (c) and (d) Since funds for Total Literacy Campaings are released to the implementing agencies on project basis for a specified time-frame, no year-wise details of expenditure are compiled. State-wise break-up of amount released to State Governments, utilised and unspent balances under the Scheme of Operation Black Board from 1987-88 to 1997-98 is given in Annexure.
