Privatisation of Postal Services

1299. SHRI K.M. SAIFULLAH: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether postal services are to be privatised partially; and

(b) if so, the details thereof especially in respect of postal agencies in the Andhra Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI KABINDRA PURKAYASTHA):

(a) and (b) Participation of the private sector in postal services has been marginal and that too in the role of augmen-

ting the efforts of the Department to provide basic postal facilities in the needy areas. Private agencies have been participating in identified area of activity like sale of stamps and stationery, transportation of mail and provision of additional public facilities at a few places, like Post Shoppe. In Andhra Pradesh also activities like sale of postage stamps and stationery through licensed stamp vendors is in vogue.

Popularisation of Internet for Educational Purpose

1300. SHRI K. RAHMAN KHAN: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the measures taken by Government to make the internet more popular for educational purpose;

(b) whether Government would consider providing the internet connection at cheaper rates to the educational institutions; and

(c) how many educational institutions have 64 Kbps connections State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI KABINDRA PURKAYASTHA): (a) and (b) The internet access on dial up basis is available on concessional basis for the students of class XI & above for which only Rs. 500⁷- are charged as the Annual (or 500 Hrs. whichever is earlier) usage charges. Further w.e.f. .1.1.98 the educational Institutions are charged Rs. 4 lacs per annum instead of the normally charged Rs. 8 lacs per annum for the 64 Kbps port. The relevant Circulars are annexed herewith as Statement-I (See below).
