New National water Policy

1394. SHRI P. PRABHAKAR REDDY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a new National Water Policy aimed at ensuring equitable distribution of water amongst all the States and more effective and scientific management of water resources is on the anvil;

(b) if so, whether the views of the various State Governments would be sought for and duly considered before formulating the policy; and

(c) whether the said policy would make adequate safeguard against the reckless exploitation of ground water resources which harms the future of country's agriculture?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SOMPAL): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. A National Water Policy was adopted by National Water Resources Council, under the Chairmanship of the Prime Minister, in 1987. The Policy is proposed to be reviewed and updated in the context of experiences gained during the last ten years of its implementation and emerging challenges. In this context, a revised/updated National Water Policy has recently been finalised by the National Water Board (NWB) in its tenth meeting

held on 29th October, 1998 for its further consideration and adoption by the National water Resources Council. In addition, a draft National Policy Guidelines for Water Allocation amongst States has also been finalised by the National Water Board for consideration of the National Water Resources Council.

(c) The draft revised/updated National Water Policy includes, inter-alis, adequate safeguards against over exploitation of ground water.
