VLPTs

Palampur Thanedar	VLPT functioning at DoT premises.
Bijli Mahadev	Decision for cositing the VLPT at DoT premises still exists, not yet installed.
Dalhousie Chunaghai	Not installed at DoT premises due to site constraints.
Ajhufort	DoT sharing VLPT site, VLPT functional.
Nehri, Tissa Ashapuri	Doordarshan has proposed to DoT authorities for co-setting VLPTs at DoT premises. Functioning may start within two months after receipt of DoT approval.

Offensive characterisation of Freedom Fighters in Film "JINNAH"

1334. SHRIMATI KAMLA SINHA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the offensive characterisation of Mahatma Gandhi, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru and other freedom fighters besides distortion of history in a film "Jinnah" recently screened in London film festival and invited to a film festival in Kerala;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to review the film before it is screened in Kerala film festival; and

(c) if so, the steps taken in this direction?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI): (a) to (c) The Central Board of Film Certification has not received any application for certification of the film 'Jinnah' so far. According to the Chalachitra Academy of Kerala, which organises the International Film Festival of Kerala '99, the film 'Jinnah' has not been invited for screening in the Festival. The question of reviewing the film will arise only if it is received for screening in the Festival.
