health, education, child-care, nutrition, water and sanitation. Each group is given one time grant of Rs. 25,000/- as revolving fund contributed by the Government of India and the State Government in the ratio of 50:50 for infrastructure, purchase of raw materials, marketing, child care, etc.

(vii) Training of Rural Youth for Self Employment (TRYSEM) The programame aims at providing basic technical and managerial skills to rural youth from families below the poverty line to enable them to take up self-employment and wage employment in agriculture and allied sectors, industries, services and business activities.

(viti) Supply of Improved Toolkits to Rural. Artisans (SITRA) The objective of the programme is to enable the rural artisans to enhance the quality of the product, increase the production and their income and lead a better quality of life with use of modern tools. The beneficiary is to contribute 10 per cent of the cost of the toolkits. The remaining 90 per cent is the subsidy from the Government of India
