(c) whether Government have examined/accepted any other recommendations of the three-member Task Force, headed by former Defence Minister, Shri K. C. Pant, on whose recommendations above mentioned NSC has been constituted?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES):

(a) A six member National Security Council (NSC) has been set up. The Strategic Policy Group under the NSC will undertake the strategic defence review as one of its priority tasks.

(b) The functions of the NSC would include reviewing, monitoring, making long-term prognoses and considering policy options on all aspects of national security of the country.

(c) The recommendations of the K. C. Pant Task Force were taken into consideration in the Government decision on setting up the NSC.
