- (a) wheher Government are aware that three Indian Army men have been missing from the Line of Control in north Kashmir since the last week of October;

- (c) wheher there is any chance of those Army men straying into Pakistan; and

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) to (d) One JCO and two are missing from Uri Sector since 21st October. 1998 and one OR from Kargil Sector since 17th October, 1998 Extensive search of the area has been carried out. However the missing militarymen could not be traced.

## Shelter for Assam ultras in adjoining countries

#### \*257. SHRI O. RAJAGOPAL; PROF. VIJAY KUMAR MALHOTRA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware that Assam Ultras/insurgents are taking shelter/enjoying sanctuaries in adjoining countries of Bhutan, Bangladesh and Mynamar;

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L. K. ADVA-NI) (a) to (c) According to available information, there are camps neighbouring in some of our countries which are being used North-East insurgent groups as safe havens and sanctuaries and for training purposes. The matter been taken up with these countries and they have assured that they will not allow undesirable elements to use their territory for activities prejudicial to the interests of India.

### Pak teams not to play/visit Mumbai

- \*258. SHRI GHUFRAN AZAM: Will the Minister of HOME AF-FAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Shiv Sena Supremo in Mumbai has recently stated that he will not allow Pakistani Cricket or Hockel team to visit or play matches in Mumbai;

- (b) if so, in what capacity, the Shiv Sena Supremo has made such announcements;
- (c) whether Government would take immediate action against the Shiv Sena Supremo and direct the Maharashtra Government to allow Pakistani Cricket/Hockey team to play matches in Mumbai; and

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L. K. ADVA-NI): (a) and (b) According to some media and other reports. Shri Bal Thackeray, Pramukh Shiv Sena, has stated that Pakistan Cricket Team would not be allowed to play in Maharashtra/India.

(c) and (d) The venues of cricket and hockey matches to be played in India have not been finalised as yet. Appropriate action in the matter will be taken in due course.
