Upgradation of Ahmedabad Airport

2488. SHRI BANGARU LAXMAN: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) Ahmedabad Airport is being upgraded in phases to international standards for the operation of B-747 class of aircraft. In phase-I, the runway is being strengthened and extended to 11500' alongwith associated payment works. The work has been awarded and is scheduled to be completed by November, 2000.
