THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI SIS RAM OLA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) The fact whether family members of the employees of North East Sector of NPCC were at the verge of starvation had been enquired into and there had been no such incident.

Involvement of Farmers in Command Area Development Programme

(a) whether Government had asked the State Governments to involve farmers in the Command Area Development Programme(CADP);

(b) if so, the action taken/proposed to be taken by the State Governments in this regard;

(c) the number of farmer's association formed by different States for the purpose; and

(d) the steps taken by Government for the effective implementation of the Command Area Development Programme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI SIS RAM OLA): (a) Yes, Sir. The Union Government had advised State Governments to involve farmers in management of irrigation water.

(b) and (c) Statewise details are given at Statement (See below).

(d) For effective implementation of the Programme the Union Government has been issuing guidelines to State Governments from time to time, has taken up evaluation studies of some projects to identify constraints in the

implementation of the programme, intensified monitoring, held regular meetings of officers of State Government concerned with implementation of the Programme to discuss their problems and sponsored training programmes.

ANDHRA PRADESH:	To provide legal status to Water Users' Associations, the State Government have enacted the "Andhra Pradesh Farmers' Management of Irrigation System Act—No. 11-1997" which provides for creation of Water Users' Associations. Government have notified the formation of 10292 Water Users' Associations including 1170 associations in the projects under Command Area Development Programme and election to 9705 Water Users' Associations (WUAs) have been held.
2.	ASSAM	The State Government have constituted a High Level Working Group under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary to formulate policy issues for Participatory Irrigation Management. Two Farmers' Associations have been formed
3.	BIHAR	Paliganj distributory in Sone Command with a command area of 12,200 ha. and involving 75 villages has been handed over to the Water Users' Association for operation and management.
4.	GOA	Government of Goa have enacted "The Goa Command Area Development Act, 1997" to implement farmers' participation under Command Area Development Programme. So far 39 Water Distribution Cooperative Societies have been formed.
5.	GUJARAT:	A High Level Working Group under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary has been set up in March 1994 to formulate the policy issues relating to Participatory Irrigation Management. Seventy one Farmers' Associations have been formed. Further thirteen pilot projects for forming farmers' associations have been taken up.
6.	HARYANA:	Under Command Area Development Programme, Water Users' Associations at the outlet level have been formed. So far, 554 Water Users' Associations have been formed.

The agreements of both these projects were signed with OECF in 1288.
