THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Selection and recruitment of PGT, TGT and Primary Teachers are made by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan as per the recruitment rules framed for the purpose which lays down the prescribed qualifications. Public advertisements are issued for the purpose and applicants are short-listed for interview on the basis of pre-determined norms which are based upon academic/professional achievements and achievements in co-curricular activities.

(b) It was not necessary to conduct written tests for selection of teachers as per rules or as per advertisements so far.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) Does not arise.

(e) Since the recruitment of teachers is made on all India basis the statistics regarding candidates belonging to different regions are not maintained. The details of number of teachers appointed in the North-East Region and number of teachers transferred from the region, year-wise during the last 05 years are as under:—

(b) if the figures received in the Depository Libraries do not reflect the correct position of the books published what action has been taken to remedy the situation;

(c) whether all the four libraries have adequate space to accommodate and service the books received; and

(d) if not, the steps begin taken by Government to provide proper facilities to the libraries?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Under the Delivery of Book Act, 1954 there are 4 Depository Libraries

1. National Library, Calcutta
2. Delhi Public Library, Delhi
3. State Central Library,, Mumbai

4. Connemara Public Library, Chennai

The number of titles, these depository libraries received in 1997-98 under Delivery of Books Act, 1954 is given in Statement-I [See below).

The Statewise position in respect of national Library, Calcutta, State Central Library, Mumbai is given in Statement-II (see below). Connemara Public Library, Chennai and Delhi Pubic Library, Delhi do not maintain Statewise records.

(b) With a view to make the Act more effective. Government of India (Department of Culture) has taken steps to review the Delivery of Books Act, 1954 through a Committee under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, Department of Culture.

(c) and (d) The space available in the National Library, Calcutta, Connemara Public Library, Channai and State Central Library, Mumbai needs improvement. Action has been taken to construct a 'Bhasha Bhavan' in National Library.
