THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) the number of persons covered/enrolled, state-wise during the last 2 years, yearwise under the National Literacy Mission and National Open School is given in the Statement enclosed (See below). The Scheme of Operation Black Board envisages only the creation of infrastructural facilities and sanction of additional posts of teachers.

(b) and (c) Procedural and other shortcomings in the implementation of these schemes are brought to the notice of Government from time to time.

Operation Black Board Scheme was last reviewed and revised in 1993. The performance of Total Literacy Campaigns was reviewed by the Expert Group on Evaluation of Literacy Campaigns in India in 1994. These reviews have sought to remedy shortcomings in the operation of these schemes. The working of all these schemes would be discussed in the forthcoming meeting of the Education Ministers of all the States and Union Territories.
