### Humanising the Police Force

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L.K. ADVANI): The Government have been laying adequate emphasis on sensitising the police personnel and to infuse in them the basic human values. Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR & D) has conducted a series of seminars/workshops on human rights, in collaboration with Org. unisations. For the long-term. BPR &D has incorporated inputs on Huma n Rights and a Code of Conduct in the incluction as well as in-service training courses designed for different levels viz., Constables of IPS officers.

#### Funds for BADP

### 1538. SHRI RAM NATH KOVIND: DR. RANBIR SINGH:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a proposal from Uttar Pradesh Government has been received for sanction of funds for Border Area Development Programme (BADP);
  - (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the funds have been disbursed; and
  - (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L.K. ADVANI): (a) to (d) Yes, Sir. The Government of Uttar Pradesh had sent a proposal to Planning Commission seeking financial assistance Border Area Development Programme (BADP) for strengthening the infrastructure along the Indo-Nepal border but, since BADP is not applicable to Indo-Nepal border, no financial assistance has been released by the Planning Commission. Ministry of Home Affairs had, however, released Rs. 2.00 crores during 1996-97 for strengthening the police set up along the Indo-Nepal border under the Modernisation of State Police scheme. Another amount of Rs.6.26 crores has been released during 1997-98 under the same scheme.
