1954. SHRI GHUFRAN AZAM: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether thousands of students of Delhi and adjoining States are visiting Karnataka (Bangalore) to appear in CET-98 examination to be held on 13/14 June. 1998; and
- (b) whether due to non availability of confirmed seats in trains, these students are facing a lot of difficulties?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAM NAIK): (a) and (b) A large number of passengers are there on the waiting list in Karnataka Express train leaving New Delhi on 09-06-1998. & 10-06-1998. Apart from augmenting the train, a special train from Delhi to Bangalore was run on 09.06.1998 to clear extra rush and instructions have been given to run a special train from Bangalore to Delhi on 14.06.1998.

Gauge conversion between Kollam and Madural

- (a) whether the work to convert the railways metre gauge line from Kollam to Madurai will be taken during the year 1998-99; and
 - (b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAM NAIK): (a) and (b) Gauge conversion of Kollam-Virudhunagar is an approved work to be taken up after obtaining the requisite clearances. Action in this regard has been initiated. Virudhunagar-Madurai BG line already exists.

Computerisation of Railway Station in Raiasthan

1957. SHRI RAMDAS AGARWAL: Will the Minister of RAILV/AY3 be pleased to state:

- (a) how many railway stations in Rajasthan and Orissa States have so far been computerised being modernised, State-wise; and
- (b) the estimated cost involved, Statewise, indicating whether there has been cost over-runs in the implementation of modernisation thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI 1) RAM NAIK): (a) Computerised reservation facilities have been provided at 14 stations in Rajasthar, and 8 stations in Orissa. Provision of such facilities at Bhilwara in Rajasthan has been included in the Annual Plan 1998-99. This is in addition to the stations where the work relating to these facilities is in progress.

(b) Rajasthan Rs. 537.65 lakhs and Orissa Rs. 123.00 lakhs. There has been not cost over-run.
