Discrimination in Reimbursement of Medical Claims In Air India

2927. SHRI A. VIJAYA RAGHAVAN: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Air India medical department has received any complaints regarding discrimination in reimbursement of medical claim for eye operations under contributory medical scheme; and

(b) if so, what action has been taken on the complaints?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. A representation was received for reimbursement of medical expenses for Myopia Correction. The claim was rejected as the same was not admissible under the Contributory Medical Benefit Scheme and Employees Benefit Scheme.

Reimbursement of Medical Expenses Under Contributory Medical Scheme of Air India

2928. SHRI A. VIJAYA RAGHAVAN: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) the rules for reimbursement of medical expenses for Keratotomy Eye operation under the Contributory Medical Scheme of Air India;

(b) the number of applications considered for above reimbursement and those rejected in the years 1996, 1997 and 1998; and

(c) the reasons for each rejection of above claim, if any?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) Medical expenses for photo Refractive Keratotomy for

Myopia correction (Correction of eye sight only) are neither reimbursable under the Contributory Medical Benefits Scheme (CMBS) nor Employees Medical Benefits Scheme (EMBS) in Air India.

(b) and (c) Details are as under:—

The claim passed related to Keratotomy done alongwith Vitrectomy and Tridectomy for retinal detachment and was admissible under CMBS. The rejected claim related to Keratotomy as it was not admissible under CMBS and EMBS.
