THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI SUSHMA SWARAJ): (a) Yes Sir.

(b) Government have decided to permit Indian Satellite Channel to uplink from Indian soil through VSNL. All private Channel Operators presently "On air" unanimously welcomed this decision to allow uplinking from Indian soil.

(c) Does not arise.

Harmonium Performers of Carnatic Music

3032. DR. RAJA RAMANNA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether harmonium solo performers of Carnatic music are forbidden from playing the instrument in All India Radio;

(b) if so, the reasons for this discrimination; and

(c) whether with the good harmoniums now available performers will be given contracts as with other musicians?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI SUSHMA SWARAJ): (a) and (b) No, Sir. There is no discrimination. Only "A" grade artists are allowed solo performance in All India Radio. At present there is no "A" grade harmonium artist in All India Radio panel.

(c) After the introduction of the system of audition for harmonium artists also, all graded artists, depending on their grades, are offered bookings as per the requirement of the station.

Independent Radio/TV Facilities for Amritsar

3033. SHRI KARTAR SINGH DUGGAL: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that Amritsar town is not adequately covered by All India Radio, Jalandhar transmitter;

(b) whether it is a fact that Amritsar falls in its skip-distance and its signal in the town is weak; if so, what steps are being taken to remedy this age old malady; and

(c) considering the importance of Amritsar as pilgrimage, cultural, educational and commercial centre, whether there is any plan to provide it with independent Radio and TV facilities to cater to the Majha region?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI SUSHMA SWARAJ): (a) Amritsar town is fully covered by the High Power Medium Wave Transmitters of All India Radio at Jalandhar.

(b) There is no skip zone in medium wave coverage.
