with the Maldives, a friendly neighbouring country. Government have assisted the Government of Maldives under its bilateral technical assistance programme. Such cooperation has included the construction of a general hospital as well as of a technical institute in the Maldives. Government also assists the Maldives in its efforts at human resource development in a variety of fields including health, education and technical training. During the visit of the President of Maldives to India from June 30-July 1, 1998, the growth of bilateral economic cooperation was among the subjects reviewed.

Wasteful expenditure in Indian Missions

- 4037. SHRI GHUFRAN AZAM: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI VASUNDHRA RAJE): (a) to (c) Utmost attention is given to avoiding any excessive or wasteful expenditure in Indian diplomatic Missions abroad. Detailed and specific instructions have been issued to our Embassies abroad to identify areas where strick control could effectively curtail expenditure without compromising efficiency in the working of the Mission/Posts. The Proposals and expenditure figures received from Missions are carefully examined and in critical areas where there remains a tondency for the expenditure to increase have been identified and the expenditure figures in respect thereto are regularly monitored and corrective measures taken from time to time. The expenditure is subjected to post-audit by the Office of the Chief Controller of Account and is also subject to statutory sudit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.

These measures have been generally successful in achieving the objectives and effective in controlling the expenditure. This is, however, an engoing energies.
