Implementation as an apex body for monitoring of Government projects costing Rs. 20 crore and above provides objective monitoring and evaluation independent of planning and implementing agencies at one place and assists the Government in better management on projects. On the basis of the reports of the Department of Programme Implementation of projects costing Rs. 100 crores and above, the Cabinet Secretariat holds meetings from time to time to resolve intricate inter-ministerial issues/problems relating to the implementation of major projects.

Construction of Barak Dam
