of such reasources for the housing sector alone may be difficult.

In view of the above, the Government is focusing on its commitment of Housing for all. The National Agenda for Goverance has recognised housing for all as a priority area and envisages construction of an additional 20 lakh houses every year in the country.

Central Assistance under NRY for Night Shelter and Sanitation Facilities

- 4417. DR. JAGANNATH MISRA: Will the Minister of URBAN AFFAIRS AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) the number of schemes sanctioned by Government under the Nehru Rozgar Yojana for providing night shelters and sanitation facilities to the pavement dwellers during the past three years till date in the country, specially in Bihar;

(c) the State wise number of pesons benefitted by these schemes?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN AFFAIRS AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA): (a) The erstwhile Nehru Rozgar Yojana (discontinued with effect from 1.12.97) did not have a component of Night Shelter and Sanitation Facility for Urban Footpath Dwellers. However, there is a separate Central sector scheme of Night Shelter & Sanitation Facility for Urban Footpath Dwellers. Under this Scheme, HUDCO has sanctioned a total nubmer of fourteen projects during the past three years that is from 1995-96 to 1997-98, out of which three schemes are in Bihar.

(b) State wise and year wise details of above mentioned schemes indicating Central subsidy released and number of night shelters, beds, WC, baths etc. are given in the enclosed Statement (See below)
