(e) by when all the applications are likely to be cleared?

Implementation of Justice Talwar Committee Report

4473. SHRI RAJ NATH SINGH: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Justice Talwar Committee report on functioning of extra-departmental post-office had submitted its report many years ago;

(b) if so, the stage of implementation of the recommendations of this Committee;

(c) the main reasons for the delay in accepting the recommendations;

(d) whether it is a fact that postal employees have gone on strike to press for implementation of recommendation of the Committee; and

(e) by when the recommendation are likely to be accepted by Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI KABINDRA PURKAYASTHA): (a) Justice Talwar Committee submitted its report only on 30.4.97.

(b) Recommendations are under active considerations of Govt.

(c) Recommendations of Justice Talwar Committee for Extra Departmental Agents are based on the recommendations of the Vth Central Pay Commission for Central Government employees, a major part of which relating to scales of pay, allowances, etc. came to be implemented *vide* Govt. Notifications dated 30.9.97 and 3.10.97 respectively. Thereafter, orders for implementing a major recommendation of Justice Talwar Committee to increase the fixed monthly allowance of Extra Departmental Agents w.e.f. 1.1.96 by multiplying the same with 3.25 were issued on 12.11.97.
