

Trauma Centres on National Highways

4573. SHRI YERRA NARAYANA-SWAMY: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether "Trauma Centers" have been established along the National Highways by NHAI;

(b) if so, the number of such "Trauma Centres" set up;

(c) the details of their location; and

(d) the funds allotted for this purpose by NHAI for 1998-99?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (DR. DEBENDRA PRADHAN):

Conversion of State Highways into National Highways in Karnataka

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (DR. DEBENDRA PRADHAN): (a) and (b) State Government of Karnataka has sent the following proposals of State Highways for declaration as new National Highways:

1. Tumkur-Honnarav	563
2. Srirangapatanam-Bidar	740
3. Mangalore-Thirthahalli-Shimoga-Harihar	200

(c) The proposals would be considered alongwith those from other States based on their *inter-se* priority and availability of adequate funds.
