Offices of Punjabi Academy

359. SHRI KARTAR SINGH DUGGAL:
Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the offices of the Punjabi academy, an autonomous organisation under the Union Territory, Delhi are housed in

a public utility services building in a congested area of the town in a most unhygienic surroundings;

(b) whether it is also a fact that almost similar is the plight of other Academies in the Union Territory, if so, whether there is any plan to provide them with respectable accommodation; and

(c) whether Cultural Complex for Union Territory is proposed to be constructed where all the Academies are suitably accommodated?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) The Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi have informed that the office of the Punjabi academy is presently situated in Community Centre, Sadar Thana Road. Although, this is a congested locality but the surroundings are not unhygienic.

(b) and (c) Delhi Govt. have further informed that presently there is not plant to accommodate all academies at one place. However, they keep on acquiring more accommodation for various offices required from time to time. Such an exercise may be helpful for allotting alternative accommodation to any of the academies experiencing difficulty.

(ख) और (ग) बिहार में "स्कूलों में कम्प्यूटर साक्षरता और अध्ययन" (क्लस योजना) की संशोधन-पूर्व योजना के अंतर्गत 123 स्कूल शामिल किए गए हैं। इससे लाभान्वित छात्रों की कुल संख्या के बारे में आकड़ा इस विभाग में नहीं रखा जाता है।

Scheme of Apprenticeship training for vocational students

(d) when a decision on this proposal will be taken?

(b) to (d) In pursuance of the recommendation of 27th meeting of Central Apprenticeship Council (CAC) held on 17.12.1996, a working Group has been constituted to suggest changes in the Apprentices Act, 1961 and rules framed thereunder in the light of new economic policy in respect of graduate engineer, technician and technical (vocational) apprentices. The Working Group constituted is looking into the various aspects of the scheme in respect of graduate engineer, technician and technician (vocational) apprentices as per the terms of reference and guidelines suggested to the Working Group.

Misappropriation of World Bank Aid in Bihar
