Task forces for defence design

defence design, development, production and marketing of products; and

THE- MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) Six task forces have been constituted by the Ministry of Defence to submit recommendations to enhance partnership between the Defence Ministry and the Industry.

(b) These Joint Task Forces have been constituted to submit recommendations in the following areas with a view to enhance the partnership with the Industry:—

- (i) Defence-Industry Long Term Partnership, (ii) Commercial Process, (iii) DRDO-Industry Partnership, (iv) Private Sector Undertakings/ Ordnance Factories/Private Sector complimentary, (v) Defence Export Strategy, (vi) Information Technology for Defence.
