- 3. Harishankar Narusimhanath -Hirakud - Sambalpur - Vedvyas (Gandhamardhan Circuit).
- 4. Koraput Araku Valley Nandapur - Gupteswar - Rayagada (Panchabati Circuit).
- (b) and (c) Development of tourist circuits is the responsibility of the State Governments/Union territory Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India provides financial assistance for development of tourism infrastructure on the basis of specific project proposals received from State Governments/Union Territory Administrations and availability of funds. Ministry of Tourism. Government of India sanctioned financial assistance of Rs. 358.85 lakhs for the implementation of 14 projects in the identified circuits during the last five years.
