

Norms Governing Transfer in KVS

1156. SHRI RAJ NATH SINGH: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the norms that govern transfers on request within a region particularly in the Delhi region;

(b) whether these norms are being followed;

(c) the school-wise details of various cases of primary teachers of Delhi region who have applied for the transfers on request within the Delhi region and in other regions;

(d) by when these transfers would be effected; and

(e) what is the school-wise present position of sanctioned strength, teachers in position, supernumerary teacher, teachers on contractual basis and vacancies in respect of Primary Teachers in the various Kendriya Vidyalayas of Delhi region?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUM RAM SAIKIA): (a) and (b) The transfers within region including Delhi Region are done as per transfer guidelines approved by Board of Governors, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, in its 54th meeting held on 22.8.90 as amended in 56th meeting held on 6.9.93.

Grants by AICTE

1157. PROF. RAM BAKSH SINGH VARMA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) how much resources and other grants have been distributed by the All India Council for Technical Education during 1996-97;

(b) what is the regional distribution of these grants in North, East and South;

(c) whether there is any regional imbalance in the distribution of the grants; and

(d) if so, what are the steps being taken to remove regional imbalance?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUHI RAM SAIKIA): (a) to (d) During the year 1996-97 a total amount of Rs.48.72 crores was disbursed by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The regional break-up of this amount is Rs.7.31 crores for Eastern Region, Rs.12.76 crores for Western Region, Rs.11.05 crores for Southern Region and Rs.17.60 crores for the Northern Region in the country. The AICTE releases institution-based grants under various schemes on the merits of the proposals submitted.

(क) कितने प्रभावशाली और उच्च शिक्षा प्राप्त व्यक्ति रोजगार की तलाश में विदेशों में जाते हैं और इनमें से कितने प्रतिशत लोग वहां स्थाई रूप से बस जाते हैं;

(ख) क्या सरकार द्वारा उठाए गये कदमों से प्रतिभा पलायन रोकने में कोई सफलता मिली है;

(ग) यदि नहीं, तो क्या सरकार इस संबंध में कोई कानून बनाने का विचार रखती है; और

(घ) यदि हां, तो तत्संबंधी ब्यौरा क्या है?

मानव संसाधन विकास मंत्रालय में शिक्षा विभाग में राज्य मंत्री (श्री मुही राम सैकिया): (क) से (घ) रोजगार की तलाश में विदेश जाने वाले शिक्षित भारतीयों का कोई रिकार्ड नहीं रखा जा रहा है। सरकार ऐसी प्रतिभाओं को बनाए रखने के लिए देश में अनुकूल वातावरण तैयार करने के वास्ते अनेक कदम उठा रही है। इस संबंध में कोई कानून बनाने का विचार नहीं है।
