(c) Representations have been received regarding import of large quantity of cheaper imported newsprint into the country affecting the indigenous newsprint industry including Hindustan Newsprint Limited.

(d) Representations have been received from Indian Newsprint Manufacturers Association of which Hindustan Newsprint Limited is a member for imposing restriction on the import of newsprint and on 29.1.97 Government imposed "Actual User Condition" for import of newsprint.

(e) Government have not received fresh proposal for setting up of deinking Plant from Hindustan Newsprint Limited (HNL).

#### **Growth in cement export**

1309. SHRI J. CHITHARANJAN: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be

pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are satisfied with the present growth in cement exports; and

(b) how much quantity of cements have been exported to the countries in the Middle-East and South-East Asia?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN): (a) Yes, Sir. The exports of cement and clinker has gone up from 0.36 million tonnes in 1991-92 to 3.17 million tonnes in 1994-95, but it declined to 2.38 million tonnes in 1995-96 due to firm domestic demand in that year. Exports, however, shot up to 2.73 million tonnes in 1996-97.
