THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN): (a) Yes, Sir. The exports of cement and clinker has gone up from 0.36 million tonnes in 1991-92 to 3.17 million tonnes in 1994-95, but it declined to 2.38 million tonnes in 1995-96 due to firm domestic demand in that year. Exports, however, shot up to 2.73 million tonnes in 1996-97.
