THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Just one minute ...(Interruptions)... I think, you people have no manners at all. You are interrupting while I am standing on my feet and trying to bring some order in the House. I do not want this impression to go. The Prime Minister did not refuse. If he spoke in the other House, how can he refuse in this House of which he is a Member? He is here. He will come again to this House. Please do not make a fuss on such issues. We will discuss the atrocities on Dalits in Maharashtra and other places. Let the reply come. And still if you are concerned — the Prime Minister is here — we can take his time at his convenience and ask him to clear the doubts of the Members. He never refused. In fact, he offered to answer it. But, it should be done in a proper manner. That is what it is. Now, if somebody demands something, everybody gets up and tries to go at each other's throat. This is not the way. This is a very important *sadan*. ...(Interruptions)...

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY (Pondicherry):
Madam, I am very disciplined. I want your
...(Interruptions)...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: What is your discipline? ...(Interruptions)... Please let us start. Everybody knows that Kashmir is no less important than the Maharashtra situation. Whatever you may say, every situation has its own importance. If Members want to seek clarifications, the Prime Minister will say the same, what he has said in the other House. Why is there so much agitation and heat? I do not

understand, Mr. Wasim, why you are getting up. Police firing on Dalits in Mumbai and atrocities committed on them in other parts of Maharashtra

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, the issue is, the atrocities on the Dalits in Maharashtra on 11 th July, cannot be separated from the political environment and the complexion of the political rule that has been set up. Therefore, at the beginning, I must say, something is intrinsically wrong with Maharashtra — not with the people but with the political environment, with the political complexion and with the new equation of forces that have been installed there.

Madam, I say the killing of Dalits could be attributed to the environment that has been deliberately created. The environment is one of hatred the environment is one of intolerance, the environment is one of aggressive chauvinism, and the environment is one of mounting social tension. The wrong political leadership that has been able to grab power in Maharashtra because of unusual division of forces among the democratic and secular forces, is to be held responsible for the wrong political signal that has gone down the social system in Maharashtra. That everything wrong can be done there with impunity and the wrong can be done if the people are *senas* and if the people are *sevak*s. If the people are *senas* or *sevak*s they can do wrong with impunity. This is the political signal that has been given by the new political forces which have been able to grab power there. Madam, I charge the Government

in power there that ominous forces have been let loose. Ominous forces have been let loose on the weaker sections in the State of Maharashtra. We have seen the communal clash. We have seen the caste hatred. We have seen the killing of a trade union leader of repute. We have seen the attack on journalists. We have seen the attack on newspapers. We have also seen the slogan which constitutes a^razen violation of the Indian Constitution that Maharashtra belongs to the Maharashtrians and not to the non-Maharashtrians ...*(Interruptions)*...

Thousands of Bengalis were sent out of Maharashtra on the plea that they were Bangladeshis. (Interruptions)

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: What are we discussing just now? May I ask the hon. Members? May I ask Mr. Gurudas Das Gupta as to what we are discussing? Are we discussing the atrocities?

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Yes

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Then please confine yourself to that.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: I am confining myself to that, Madam. My argument is...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Please sit down, Mr. Gurudas Das Gupta. Let me finish. Just let me finish. If you want me to control the House, please confine yourself to the atrocities. When you make a charge, please also substantiate. Otherwise, this kind of a crossfire

would not lead us anywhere. The discussion would not conclude.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, this is the intolerance that is responsible. This is the intolerance which is responsible for the killing of Dalits in Maharashtra. It is intolerance; it is political intolerance. It is this new political force of intolerance let loose which has resulted in the killing. (Interruptions)

SHRI GURU DAS DAS GUPTA: My point is that the police has only acted in conformity with the political environment. The brutality is committed by the police..

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If he is wrong, then, you correct him. It is your duty. From the Chair it is my duty to correct Members, Members put forth their figures, Members put forth their view-points. It is your duty to correct those figures, If you have better figures or if you have different figures, you have a right to

do that. We are not discussing anything in which we should score a point which state has killed how many Dalits. Are we doing that? We should not say 10 Dalits have been killed in West Bengal, 20 Dalits have been killed in Maharashtra, 5 Dalits have been killed in Tamil Nadu, in some State only one Dalit has been killed and in some State no Dalit has been killed because they have no Dalits. This is not the way to discuss it. We are discussing an issue, the atrocities that have taken place against Dalits and how we should pointedly discuss it and how we can stop it. Now, the Home Minister is here. He will tell us as to what actually happened and how we can protect them. Okay? With this peaceful request I want you to keep quiet, except one person, he should also keep quiet after two minutes.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, my short point is I was only trying to give the political background of such a wanton killing. It is true that police is responsible for the killing. The killing has been a wanton one. The killing has been unprecedented because the mob was peaceful. The only wrong thing the Dalits have done is they have picked up the courage to protect. Earlier Dalits were not having the courage to protest. Now, the only social change that has taken place in the country is the Dalits have picked up the courage to protest. The most downtrodden section of the people were speechless. The most backward people have picked up the courage to speak. That is the only wrong thing or criminality that the Dalits have committed in the country. Because of that crime they have just shot dead 11 innocent Dalits. It was a police action. The whole House agrees with me that there was no provocation from the Dalits' side, it was a peaceful mob. A story was fabricated that a tanker full of oil was there. It is all a stupid argument to befool the country. All that establishes the history. Therefore, I need not go into it. I am only trying to ask why the Police in Maharashtra picked up the courage to shower bullets and kill eleven Dalits. Indignation should be roused to find out what the social reason is, what the political background is. Madam, I say, the social and political background is the atmosphere of hatred, the atmosphere of chauvinism, the atmosphere of tension which have been deliberately let loose by a wrong political

formation. I do not mean any particular person. But it was a wrong political formation.

Madam, let us also remember that there was somebody who had said that they would not allow a cricket match to be played between India and Pakistan at the Brabourne Stadium. It created tension. Let us also remember about a particular newspaper which was ransacked by the people belonging to a particular political party. This House should discuss this matter also. It is all well known. That was defended. Madam, it was all well known only that day the reporters of particular Hindi daily were hauled up. Madam, I am saying that this has led to a situation where the police feel that they are free to do whatever they like. The police have run mad. Why have the police run mad? The police have run mad because they felt that if they took action against the Dalits, it would be in conformity with the political philosophy of the people who are in power. Madam, therefore, I am against invoking of article 356. I am against imposition of President's rule. But I would like to know from the Government how long we should tolerate all that has happened in Maharashtra. How long?

There must be a limit for our tolerations. There must be a limit. The Constitution is sacrosanct undoubtedly. But that does not mean that our toleration should be elastic, that our toleration should be infinite. Therefore, a line must be drawn for our Constitutional obligation to see that no elected government is thrown out of office. That is our understanding. But we should not fail in discharging our responsibility towards the people of a State where so much of wrong is being done.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Gurudas Das Guptaji, I am sorry. Your party did not have any time.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Madam, I would like to take only one minute more.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I have other people also.

SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Only one minute. Madam, I am concluding. The police in Maharashtra today has become the most organised gang of hooligans and a Mafia group which has no law and which does not behave

according to any law. And the Matia gangs are the creation of their political masters. Their political masters will have to feel the country how-long they will be allowed to misuse the power way they are doing Maharashtra. Thank you, Madam,

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I have so many names. I do not know how to accommodate. I tell you, I have four names from the Congress party, five names from the BJP, one name from the Janata Dal, one from the CPI, one more name from the CPI-M, one from the UPG, four names from others and one more from the Anna DMK. Even I give one minute each or two minute each, it will be long ...
