(iv) It has been decided to provision of free text books to all the students (boys and girls) from academic year 1996-97 in Std. I to IV in low female literacy blocks. From June 1996 onwards, free uniforms and writing materials are being provided to all children studying in first standard in local body schools in these blocks. This facility will be extended upto 4th standard by adding one class every year;

(v) Free education is provided to girls upto 12th Standard; and

(vi) Savitribal Phule Foster Parent Scheme is being implemented in the State under which the financial assistance at the rate of Rs. 30/-per month per girl student is made available to the girl students from the economically weaker sections.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUHI RAM SAIKIA): (a) Grants are released by Central Government to all the States including educationally backward States under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Central Schemes on the basis of the sharing pattern which varies from scheme to scheme. Programmes like DPED (District Primary Education- Programme) Total Literacy Campaigns under the Adult education Programme, Non-formal Education have a focus on educationally backward states.
