(b) whether the proposal has been pending since long;

(c) if so, the steps taken to consider the proposal; and

(d) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI C.M. IBRAHIM): (a) to (d) Doordarshan has granted script approval in respect of a scrial titled "BUDDHA TRAIL" received under New Sponsorship Scheme, 1990 from M/s. Chitra Utsav, Delhi. The producer has yet to modify the pilot for final decision by Doordarshan.

As regards the serial on Load Jagannath, one proposal titled "Mohan Jyoti" received from M/s. Biswajit Productions, Bikaner in March, 1996 was carefully considered and rejected in November, 1996 as it was not found suitable for telecast.

Criteria for selection of serials and ceiling on episodes

1143. SHRI SANJAY NIRUPAM: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state: (a) what is the criteria for selecting serials and the limit of episodes on Doordarshan;

(b) whether it is a fact that serials like Junoon, Ajnabi, Sansar and Shriman Shrimati have been extended beyond the stipulated limit of episodes; and

(c) if so, the names of serials granted extension during the last two years and the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI C.M. IBRAHIM): (a) The selection of serials in different categories is made on the basis of their suitability and programme requirement of Doordarshan. As per the guidelines, the Selection Committee while granting approval to T.V. serial specifies the number of episodes which normally does not exceed 13 in case of DD-1 and 26 in case of DD-2. Extension beyond the specified number of episodes is granted by Director General, Doordarshan keeping in view the popularity of the serial, its commercial return, quality of production and the subject requirement, etc.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The names of the T.V. serials granted extension during the last two years on DD-1 and DD-2 are given in the Statement.
