- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the action taken to stop this racket, in view of the fact that rampant indiscipline by truck and bus drivers is causing more than three thousand killings on the roads of the capital?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MOHD. MAQBOOL DAR): (a) and (b) There have been instances where individual Traffic Police personnel were found involved in malpractices but there is no indication that there exists any organised connivance. During 1996 alone, over 6 lakh trucks were challaned by Delhi Traffic Police which was almost twice the number challaned during 1995. Besides, the Delhi Traffic Police carried out a major anti-corruption drive amongst its own men as a result of which 161 Traffic Police men face departmental inquiries and other 202 officials were transferred to non-sensitive units.

## Visit by Home Minister to Assam

1263. PROF. RAM KAPSE: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether he had visited Assam in January, 1997 and the Bodo dominated areas including Kokrajhar;
- (b) if so, which other parts were visited by him;
- (c) whether he had any discussions with emissaries who have been negotiating between Ulfa and the State Government; and
  - (d) if so, the results thereto?

(c) and (d) The law & order situation was discussed with the State Govt. Various measures were suggested for dealing with the insurgency problems.
