\*492. SHRI SOLIPETA RAMA-CHANDRA REDDY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state

(a) the number of Engineering colleges and Medical colleges, State-wise;

(b) whether any proposals are pending from Government of Andhra Pradesh for opening of Engineering and Medical colleges;

(c) if so, the reasons for the pendency; and

(d) the time by which they will be cleared?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI S.R. BOMMAI): (a) to (d) The number of Engineering and Medical Colleges State-wise is given in the enclosed statement. (See below). The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has received proposals for establishment of 84 new Engineering Colleges in Andhra Pradesh. The Medical Council of India has received proposals for opening of three new Medical Colleges in Andhra Pradesh. Such proposals are processed by these statutory bodies in accordance with the prescribed procedures. Final clearance depends on the proposals fulfilling all the conditions as per the rules notified in this regard.

**Compensation to cyclone-hit fishermen of Andhra Pradesh**

\*493. DR. D. VENKATESHWAR RAO: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the fishermen of Andhra Pradesh have sought immediate compensation for those who lost their lives in cyclone in November, 1996; and

(b) if so, the action taken by Government on that plea?

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND MINISTER OF CIVIL SUPPLIES, CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI

CHATURANAN MISHRA): (a) Yes, Sir. There is a demand for payment of exgratia relief to the families of those fishermen who are still reported to be missing.

(b) The Government of Andhra Pradesh have already paid exgratia assistance at the rate of Rs. 1.00 lakh per person to the families of 192 fishermen who died in the cyclone of November, 1996. Out of the remaining cases, the State Government have now decided to treat 1279 missing fishermen as dead and give financial assistance to their families.
