

**THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN):** (a) This would be so if the dividend percentages are constant, but the amounts may not decline or could even increase if the dividend percentages go up due to higher profits.

(b) An amount of Rs. 4800 crores is estimated to be raised from disinvestment during 1997-98. The estimated revenue loss to the Govt. due to decline in dividend which the PSUs pay cannot be quantified as it depends on a number of variable factors.
