THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ): (a) Rajdhani Express already has limited number of stoppages, (b)

#### **Issue of Complimentary Card Passes to Freedom Fighters**

\*2207. SHRI RAHASBIHARI BARIK: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that free Travel Cards are issued to freedom fighters and other persons for free travel in Railways;

(b) if so, the guidelines therefor;

(c) the details of Free Travel Cards issued since January 1995; and

(d) whether any estimation has been made about the extent of loss caused to Railways on this account?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ): (a) Yes, Sir. However, cost of travel on complimentary card passes issued to Freedom Fighters is borne by the Ministry of Home Affairs.

(b) and (c) Number of complimentary card passes issued under various categories ask on 7.3.97 are as under:

Complimentary Card Pass is issued, in consultation with Ministry of Home Affairs, to Freedom Fighters of widow of a Freedom Fighter drawing pension under the Swantantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme from the Central Revenues.

In regard to category (ii) above, complimentary card passes are issued at the personal discretion of the Minister of Railways to eminent persons and organisations engaged in social, cultural, educational and welfare activities of national importance. Other categories are self explanatory.

(d) Since passes are complimentary in nature, the cost thereof is not computed excepting those passes issued to Freedom Fighters.

(a) whether Government have decided to close 536 level crossings to minimise considerable hazard to both the rail and road users to improve safety standards of Railways;

(b) if so, the names of such crossings, State and Territory-wise, with names of Zonal Railways covering these crossings;

(c) whether some of such crossings are being manned by Chowkidars at present;

(d) if so, the details of such manned and unmanned crossings;

(e) whether Government have taken any steps to implement their decision; and

(f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ): (a) Yes, Sir.
