THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUHI RAM SAIKIA): (a) to (d) According to the information furnished by UOC, All India College and University Employees Federation had submitted a representation to the Commission for inclusion of non-teaching employees within the purview of UOC. Pay scales and services conditions of non-teaching employees of State Universities/Colleges are laid down by the concerned State Governments/Universities. Laying down uniform scales of pay for such personnel will lead to serious anomalies and difficulties as the overwhelming majority of such employees perform duties and responsibilities comparable to employees in other Departments of the State Governments. Similarly, there are long established 'Post to Post' and 'Scale to Scale' parities between such employees and various other categories of employees in other departments. Disturbing the equilibrium will cause serious problems and dissatisfaction among various categories of employees within the states.
