THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI M.P. VEERENDRA KUMAR): (a) Punjab & Sind Bank has reported that subject to administrative and business requirements of the bank, managers/enior managers are rotated keeping in view, *inter alia*— their suitability at a particular branch/ office, nature and potential of business and capacity of the officer concerned as assessed to handle such business. The bank has further reported that keeping in view the above, managers'senior managers are normally rotated from one branch to the other within a period of three to five years.

(b) and (c) The bank has reported that three officers have been transferred from Zonal Office, Dehradun to other zones for reasons such as recommendations of Vigilance Department, completion of tenure and performance not being upto the mark.

(d) and (e) Request from one of the officers from Dehradun Zone was received and examined by the bank but was declined due to administrative exigencies.

Cases of reward to informers pending with Income Tax Department

4306. SHRI NARENDRA PRADHAN: Will the Minister of FI NANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is fact that final rewards to informers leading to rrids and consequent realisation of additional taxes are pending decision with IT. Department for several years;

(b) the number of cases pending where final reward has not been paid to informers, even after expiry of five years from the date of search; and

(c) the rules regarding time limit for payment of above reward to informers and what action Government contemplate for speedier disbursement of such rewards?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI M.P. VEERENDRA KUMAR): (a) Yes Sir, there are some cases of final rewards which are pending with I.T. Department for sceveal years.

(b) and (c) Interim rewards has been paid to all eligible informers. As per existing rules, final reward is to be given only on finalisation of all proceedings, including assessments and appeals, etc. and after the additional taxes attributable to the information furnished by the in-former have been realised. Many of the assessments pertaining to the aforesaid cases have not yet become final and/or taxes not recovered. Therefore, there cannot be any definite time frame for the disbursal of such reward. However, the Central Board of Direct Taxes has, from time to time, issued instructions to subordinate authorities for early disposal of such assessments and quick disbursal of reward to informants.

PIB clearance to RCFL Projects

4307, SHRI GOVINDRAO ADIK: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilisers limited (RCFL) have sought clearance from the Public Investment Board (PIB) for their new projects/ expansion of capacity/modernisation, etc.;

(b) if so, details of proposals/projects submitted by the RCFL for obtaining clearance from the Board during 1996-97;

(c) the details of action taken and proposals cleared during 1996-97; and

(d) the present status of the proposals submitted by the RCFL and pending with the Board?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI MP. VEERENDRA KUMAR): (a) to (d) No proposals of Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilisers are pending consideration by the Public Investment Board (PIB). However, one proposal relating to a Joint Venture project of RCFL—Oman—India Fertiliser Project has been received from the Department of Fertilisers. This project will be considered by the

Committee of Public Investment Board for first stage clearance in its meeting scheduled for 14.5.1997.
