- *378. PROF. A. LAKSHMISAGAR: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government is aware of Pakistan's proposal to equip its submarines with nuclear missiles;
- (b) if so, what are the defence ramifications involved in such strategic threats; and
 - (c) what measures are contemplated by Government to meet any eventuality?
- THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JASWANT SINGH): (a) and (b) Attention of the Government has been drawn to the recent media reports about Pakistan Navy's plans to equip its submarines with nuclear missiles. This will augment Pakistan Navy's capabilities.
- (c) The Government is alive to the developing situation and has undertaken all necessary measures.
