Harassment of Women in Delhi University Campus

PROF. (SHRIMATI) BHARATI RAY (West Bengal): Thank you, Madam Deputy Chairperson.

I would be very brief; not because it is getting late, but if I try to say all that I want to say, it would take one full hour.

Madam, without going into the details, I want to bring to the notice of the House the reports in various newspapers, especially, the 'Hindustan Time', about sexual harassment of girl students in one of our most prestigious institutions, namely, the University of Delhi.

As you know, Madam, it is difficult to imagine a time when womenfolk have not been subjected to some kind of a violence and harassment — physical and verbal. Even, the various forms of sexual jokes that one hears are so disgusting; at least, I do not find them at all amusing.

Already, women are being harassed on the roads, buses, trams and trains. This itself is, indeed, a very sorry state of affairs. On top of it, they are humiliated even in our educational institutions. Sexual harassment is really a way of telling the women to be in their place. It is designed to create an environment of fear. It is a display of power. It is a symbol of dominant-dominated relationship.

Madam, if our women cannot have security even in the university campuses, where would they go? Is not education a farce if the environment of education spells humiliation, demoralisation and lack of self-confidence for women, when being subjected to this kind of harassment?

Through you, Madam, I would ask the Government to take very stern measures to ensure personal safety to our women; particularly, to the girl students in our various universities, as well as to the female teachers. I would ask the Government to take steps to prevent the harassment of women. I would also invite my male colleagues to join me by raising their voice against this. Thank you.

SHRI S.B. CHAVAN (Maharashtra): We all join you.

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY (Pondichary): Everybody.

SHRIMATI KAMLA SINHA (Bihar): Madam, I would just like to add a few words to what my sister, Shrimati Bharati Ray, has just now said.

This is really a shameful state of affairs. Not only that. We also find that the boys feel excited by whatever they see in the Zee TV, M TV, etc., and in other media.

They feel excited about it and the final result is that the girls suffer. Delhi University is a prestigious University. If something like this happens in the capital city of Delhi, in the Delhi University itself, where do we look for better education for women?

We want to have power sharing, equal political power, equal political rights. We have voting powr, but our young girls, teenagers, go to college and they are sexually harassed. This is a shameful state of affairs. Thankfully, the HRD Minister is here. I would request him immediately to call a meeting of all the Vice-Chancellors and all the Departmental Heads of the Delhi Univrsity and other Universities and take immediate remedial measures.

Madam, it has also been reported in many cases, in Delhi University and other Universities that those doing post401 Special

doctoral and doctoral studies have been harassed by their Guides and Departmental Heads. This is a shameful state of affairs. The HRD Minister should react to this and he should promise that he will take remedial measures immediately. Thank you, Madam.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Mantri-ji, you are here. Please take note of it. because this should not happen.

SHRI VAYALAR RAVI (Kerala): The whole House assoiate itself with this.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The whole House feels about it. It is very distressing. And you being the Minister, we hope there will be some action because you will not allow such a thing.
