Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have

formulated any action plan for the modernisation of Major Posts in the country with the participation of private sector and foreign agencies;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the major ports in Maharashtra which are likely to be covered in the plan with details thereof; and

(d) the details of the proposals pending with Government to create additional facilities at Visakhapatnam port with private investment?

THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI T.G. VENKATRAMAN): (a) to (c) It has been assessed that demand for port capacity would be 424 million tonnes by 2002 AD which is much higher than that available at present. In order to meet a major part of requirements of port capacity, the major ports have been thrown open for private sector participation & guidelines issued for the purpose. The Major Ports of Bombay & Jawaharlal Nehru in Maharashtra are also covered by these guidelines.

(d) No such proposal is pending with the Government.
