

Rising demand for admissions in Engineering Colleges

*340. SHRI NILOTPAL BASU:
PROF. (SHRIMATI) BHARATI RAY:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that about four lakh school leavers at the 10+2 level seek admission to various engineering colleges every year;

(b) whether it is also a fact that the number of such students is increasing every year;

(c) whether it is also a fact that only two per cent of them are finally getting admission; and

(d) the plans of Government to meet the demand?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI S.R. BOMMAI): (a) to (d) The intake capacity of engineering colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education at the degree level is 1.15 lakhs (approx.). Though the exact number of students seeking admission to various engineering colleges in the country is not available, it is a fact that a large number of school leavers seek admissions. The number of actual admissions depends upon the successful fulfilment of the admission criteria prescribed by various institution and the number of seats available. Though the number of engineering colleges have gone up significantly in the recent years, the demand for admissions is bound to be always on a higher side as compared to the available admission capacity.

Rehabilitation Programme for Terrorist-Affected Women and Children

(a) whether there is any rehabilitation programme for terrorist-affected women and children in the State of Punjab; and

(b) if so, the funds released by Government under this programme during the last three years?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI S.R. BOMMAI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The State Government of Punjab has released an amount of Rs. 8461.07 lacs for providing cash relief to terrorist affected widows and children during the last three years.

Allocation for doubling of railway lines in Kerala

(a) the amount allocated for the doubling of railway lines in Kerala in this year's budget; and

(b) the amount spent as on date?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAM VILAS PASWAN): (a) Rs. 62.79 crores.

(b) Rs. 17.30 crores upto 31.10.96. The expenditure, it is expected, would get accelerated in the balance period (i.e. Oct' 96-March' 97) with increased pace of work.
