

- (xii) Regional and Sub-regional offices of Wildlife Preservation have been set-up mostly at the main export centres of the country to prevent smuggling of wildlife products.
- (xiii) Interdepartmental coordination has been enhanced with other enforcement organisations like Police, BSF, Customs, ITBP, Coast Guards etc. Training programmes on wildlife enforcement and implementation were also conducted for all these organisations at New Delhi and Dehradun during, 1995.

**Urea production in Ramagundam Fertilizer Unit**

206. DR. Y. LAKSHMI PRASAD:  
DR. ALLADI P. RAJKUMAR:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) the target set and actual quantity of Urea produced since April, 1996, in Ramagundam Fertilizer unit of F.C.I.;

(b) the reasons for shortfall in the production of Urea, and the steps taken to improve the situation; and

(c) the measures taken for ensuring regular supply of coal to the Unit?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI SIS RAM OLA):

(a) The production of urea at the Ramagundam unit of F.C.I. during the period from April to October, 1996 was 5337 metric tonnes as against the target of 33,000 metric tonnes.

(b) and (c) The major reasons for the shortfall in production of Urea are as follows:

(i) Power cut by Andhra Pradesh State Electricity Board (APSEB);

(ii) Poor coal supply from Singareni Collieries Ltd. (SCCL); and

(iii) Breakdown of equipment and

other related process problems caused mainly due to prolonged shutdown.

As a result of close coordination with State Government and the undertakings concerned, the supply of coal and power to the unit has improved.

**Setting-up of Dravidian University**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether a Dravidian University is being set-up to develop Dravidian and tribal languages;

(b) if so, the details including the significance thereof; and

(c) the contribution proposed to be given by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUHI RAM SAIKIA): (a) and (b) The Central Government has no proposal, at present, to set up any University for Dravidian and tribal Languages. The State Government of Andhra Pradesh has, however, proposed to set up one such University at Kuppam in Andhra Pradesh in collaboration with the State Governments of Kerala, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

(c) There is no proposal under consideration of the Govt. of India to provide any grant towards the capital cost of any such University.
