THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPTT. OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DHANUSHKODI ATHITHAN R.): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The Government of Manipur have indicated to the Planning Commission a requirement of Rs. 5814.02 lakhs for 1996-97 and 1997-98 for completing the construction of various kinds of sports infrastructure like main stadium, synthetic hockey field, cycle velodrome, indoor stadium, swimming pool and a 100-bedded hostel besides other miscellaneous/allied works essential for hosting the National Games.
- (c) and (d) A Central team constituted by Planning Commission visited Imphal from 24th to 29th September, 1996 to assess the requirement of funds of Government of Manipur.

- (c) Out of the estimated 22.42 lakh tonnes of inland fish production, contribution of aquaculture both fresh and brackishwater was about 16.05 lakh tonnes in 1995-96.
