THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI CM. IBRAHIM): (a) During the last three years no new airport has been opened for traffic.

(b) So far as Airports Authority of India is concerned the following airports are likely to be commissioned in the Ninth Five Year Plan:—

Ajmer in Rajasthan, Hassan in Karnataka, Kargil in Jammu & Kashmir, Itanagar in Arunachal Pradesh, Lengpui in Mizoram and Tura in Meghalaya.

(f) by when Government will clear the proposal?
