

(c) During the period from 1.10.1995 to 15.2.1996, 1104 militants were apprehended and 457 were killed. During the same period 749 AK Series Rifles, 14 Sniper Rifles, 19 Machine Guns, 13 Rocket Launchers, 376 Pistols/Revolvers besides a large number of other items like Grenades, explosives, Rocket Boosters and ammunitions etc. were recovered.

Revision of pay scale of Hindi Teachers

KRUPASINDHU BHOI): (a) to (c) Under the Scheme of Financial Assistance for Appointment and Training of Hindi Teachers in Non-hindi Speaking States/UTs., the Central Government provides 100% financial assistance as per the pay scales applicable in the States. Revision of salary is done by the State Governments and the Central Government only reimburses the expenditure.
