

million each to Orissa, U.P. Haryana and Rajasthan a loan of US \$ 1.5 million to Bihar, to undertake diagnostic studies for reforming/restructuring the State level power sector in these States with the help of international consultants.

(c) The restructuring exercise should help in improving the physical and financial performance of the power sector at State level and make their operations more commercial and viable.

(d) Government of India is assisting the States in carrying out the diagnostic studies as well as in obtaining external financial assistance from agencies such as the World Bank and ODA of UK for carrying out the reform process.

(क) क्या सरकार को इस तथ्य की जानकारी है कि बिहार में राष्ट्रीय बचत योजनाओं के एजेंटों द्वारा जाली बीजक, दस्तावेज और कागजात बनाकर दो-तरफा (डबल) कमीशन के रूप में लाखों रुपयों का दुर्विनियोग किया गया है।

(ख) यदि हां, तो तत्संबंधी ब्यौरा क्या है;

(ग) क्या सरकार किसी एजेंसी के माध्यम से इस मामले की रीढ़ी जांच करा रही है; और

वित्त मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (डा० देवी प्रसाद पाल): (क) और (ख) जी, हां। वर्ष 1988—1993 के मध्य बिहार में समस्तीपुर मुख्य डाक घर और इसके अन्तर्गत उज्जपुर उप-डाक घर में 3,54,545 रुपए के अतिरिक्त भुगतान के मामले सरकार के ध्यान में आए हैं।

SBI's Subsidiary Company

*172. SHRI YERRA NARAYANA-SWAMY: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state: (a) whether State Bank of India propose to

establish a subsidiary company for issuing credit cards and improvement of customer service;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) what specific measures SBI propose to take to improve the customer services in small towns and rural areas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (DR. DEBI PROSAD PAL): (a) State Bank of India has reported that a final decision regarding setting up such a subsidiary has not been taken.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) State Bank of India has reported that improvement in customer service is being brought about on an on-going basis in all its branches situated at metro, urban, semi-urban and rural areas. The bank has further intimated that teams of senior officers from its Local Head Offices/Zonal office regularly visit branches to assess the extent of implementation of bank's instructions for providing better customer service. The inspection team from the bank's Central office, while carrying out inspection and audit of branches, also examines the quality of customer service obtaining in the branches and suitable corrective action is taken, wherever warranted.

Revised estimates for subsidies

*173. SHRI SUSHILKUMAR SAMBAHAJIRAO SHINDE: SHRIMATI VEENA VERMA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether subsidy bill in respect of various items like food, fertilizer etc., exceeded the budget estimates for 1995-96 by about 40%;

(b) if so, how far the revised estimates for subsidies in respect of different items exceed the budget estimates for the current year and the main reasons for the increase; and
